ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR ASCON 2024

- 1. **Originality:** All abstracts must be original and not simultaneously submitted or published elsewhere.
- 2. Mode of Presentation: Choose the mode of presentation: Oral, Poster, or Either for the Scientific Category.
- 3.Language and Format: The abstract must be submitted in English as a Microsoft Word file, using Times New Roman font, size 11 point, with single line spacing.
- 4. Template for Posters/Research Papers/Case Reports: Posters, Research Papers, and Case Reports should be prepared using the provided Microsoft Presentation Template.
- 5. Submission Deadline: The deadline for abstract Submission is 15th October 2024.
- 6. **Confirmation Email:** Send the abstract in the prescribed format via email to ascoindia06@gmail.com.
- 7. **Presentation at the conference**: Guidelines of presenting (Oral/Poster) at the venue will be provided via email upon acceptance of abstract by scientific committee.

SCIENTIFIC AND NON-SCIENTIFIC ABSTRACT GUIDELINES FOR ASCON 2024

- 1. **Word Limit:** Abstracts can be up to 350 words for Original Research and 500 words for Case Studies.
- 2. Original Work: All submissions must be the original work of the presenting author(s).

3. Eligibility:

- a.Non-Scientific Category: B. Optom students are welcome to submit abstracts/posters.
- b. Scientific Category: Interns (B. Optom), M. Optom/PG students, faculty, and practitioners are welcome to submit abstracts.
- 4. Case Study Abstracts: For Case Studies, the abstract should be submitted on one page, containing the Title, Case Summary (including findings, diagnosis, intervention, outcome), Conclusion, and Recommendation.
- 5. Original Research Abstracts: For Original Research, the abstract should be submitted on one page, containing the Title, Introduction, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.
- 6. **Spelling and Grammar:** It is the author's responsibility to submit an abstract with correct spelling and grammar. The Selection Committee reserves the right to edit, send back, or reject the abstract if it contains significant spelling or grammatical errors or does not adhere to the guidelines.
- 7. **Notifications:** Receipt of abstracts, along with acceptance or rejection notifications, will be sent to the email provided. Notification of abstract acceptance will be made approximately one month after the closing date for abstract submissions.
- 8. **Submission Limit:** There is no limit to the number of abstracts one may submit, provided the presenter has registered for the ASCON 2024 conference.
- 9. **Publication:** The Committee reserves the right to publish accepted abstracts in ASCO's official journal, the Journal of Optometry and Vision Science.
- 10. **Copyright:** ASCO India holds the copyright to all materials presented at the Conference.

- 11. Presenting Author: The first author will be the presenting author.
- 12. **Conference Attendance:** The presenting author is expected to register, attend the conference, and give the presentation (no online presentations).
- 13. Awards: Outstanding presentations will be awarded a Certificate of Excellence or Memento by ASCO India for each category, only during the conference.
